Laboratories with an asterisk () also participate in the CDC Environmental *Legionella* Isolation Techniques Evaluation (**ELITE**) Program. This is a voluntary proficiency testing program that certifies labs in the isolation of *Legionella* from water samples using **culture methods**. ELITE member labs must correctly identify proficiency samples sent to them twice per year. Certification must be renewed annually.

The CDC ELITE Program does not certify performance of molecular (e.g., PCR), serological (e.g., DFA), or rapid analytical tests (e.g., dipstick) because methods other than culture are not discriminating enough to be applied as a primary test to environmental samples. These other methods are suitable for supplemental testing only.

Beginning in 2017, the CDC ELITE Program will become fee for service and participants will be charged an annual fee.
